Dear Mr. Makarewicz and Members of the Chicago Society Foundation,

Thank you so much for your very generous donation of \$4000 from the Chicago Society Foundation to the Polish Scouting Organization of Illinois for two scholarships of \$2000 each for deserving college bound scouts. The two scholarships were awarded to przewodniczka Oliwia Łakomy and ćwik Dawid Cieśla in the fall of 2020 during the Covid-19 pandemic. The awards were presented at a Mass celebrated by pastor Andrzej Totzke at Holy Trinity Parish on November 8th, 2020, honoring the 102^{nd} Polish Independence Day.

Oliwia Łakomy is a student at the University of Illinois at Chicago studying Biochemistry. She has been an active harcerka for over 11 years and is now an instructor. Oliwia's scholarship application included the following quote:

"Harcerstwo jest i zawsze będzie wielką częścią mojego życia. Bycie Polakiem za granicą Polski nie jest łatwe, ale harcerstwo zapewnia mi ciągłe połączenie do mojej ojczyzny. Przyjaciele, których poznałam w harcerstwie, mają te same moralne wartości co ja i wiem, że zawsze mogę na nich liczyć, a oni na mnie."

Translation: "Polish Scouting is and always will be a big part of my life. Being a Pole outside of Poland is not easy, but scouting guarantees a link to my heritage. Friends, whom I met in Polish Scouts have similar values to me, and I know that I can count on them and they on me."

Dawid Cieśla is a student at DePaul University studying pre-med with a goal of becoming a doctor. He has been an active harcerz for over 11 years as well. Dawid's scholarship application included the following quote:

"Harcerstwo miało ogromny wpływ na moje życie, szczególnie podczas moich lat jako drużynowy. Moja funkcja jako drużynowy nauczyła mnie większej odpowiedzialności i podejście do prowadzenia grupy ludzi."

Translation: "Polish Scouting had a huge influence on my life, especially when I was the scout troop leader. My role as troop leader taught me greater responsibilities and how to be a leader among a group of people."

Thank you again to the Chicago Society Foundation for your support of these two Polish scouts. We look forward to working with in the future.

- 1. Call to Order: President Konopka called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.
- 2. Roll Call of Officers and Directors present: Brs. Konopka, Cwiakala, Ciesla, Plachta, Wasilewski, Dykas, Kurdziel, Absent: Brs. Kozelka, Matuszczak, Kogut, Grzadziel, Haszlakiewicz, Quorum achieved.
- 3. Approval of minutes: The minutes for the July 21st General meeting and tonight's Board meeting will be approved at the August General meeting.
- 4. Correspondence:— (1) Thank you letter from the Polish Scouting Association for our contribution. (2) An announcement from the District 13 Women's Division regarding scholarships. (3)An anonymous letter providing two tickets to the Dzien Polski at Riverview Park from July18, 1926 that the person found in a book purchased at a garage sale. Motion to forward correspondence to the Editor for printing in the Forum made by Br. Ciesla, seconded by Br. Wasilewski. Motion passed.
- <u>5. Bills:</u> Bills presented for payment are the Forum printing and mailing to SFI, August issue, \$132.75 and the cost of tonight's meeting. Motion to pay for the bills made by Br. Ciesla, seconded by Br. Dykas. Motion passed.
- 6. Directors and Officers Reports:

<u>1* Vice-President:</u> Br. Chris Grzadziel was absent – All were asked to call Br. Grzadziel if they had any suggestions for speakers.

2^{md} Vice-President: Br. Chuck Cwiakala – Our next General Meeting will be at The Great Escape, 9450 W. Irving Park Rd. There are very few venues that could provide dinners at our established budget of \$20 per member. We need to explore other options. Discussion followed on charging a small fee at the door to help cover the cost of the meals if they exceed the \$20.00 past precedence, that is if the meal will cost \$25.00 the member would be charged for the extra \$5.00 cost. This will be a thought for future discussions.

<u>Secretary:</u> Br. Haszlakiewicz was absent. No report

<u>Financial Secretary:</u> Br. Ciesla - report was emailed to board prior to meeting. Total deposits for 2021 amounts to \$36,476.31. Mr. Wiecek is paid to date. He still owes \$4291.04 with 19 payments remaining. We have 92 members, with 3 waived dues. One person is waiting to be inducted. Two members have requested reinstatement and have paid their dues for 2021; Brs. Joseph Bauerle and Frank Spula. This will bring our membership up to 94 members. Motion made by Br. Dykas to reinstate Brs. Bauerla and Spula, seconded by Br. Cwiakala. Motion passed. Br. Cwiakala moved to accept report, seconded by Br. Kurdziel. Motion passed.

<u>Treasurer:</u> Br. Plachta – report emailed to board prior to meeting. Current balance is \$62,461.66. Br. Wasilewsski moved to accept report, Br. Kurdziel seconded. Motion passed.

Advocate: Br. Wasilewski – No report

<u>Director of Publications:</u> Br. Kozelka was absent – However please send content for Forum.

<u>Director of Outreach:</u> Br. Matuszczak was absent. – No report.

<u>Senior Director:</u> Br. Dykas – no report.

<u>Social Activities Director:</u> Br. Kurdziel – Br. Konopka reported that the golf outing was successful. We maxed out at 84 golfers. Dinner will have about 95 people. PolVision was there. Good publicity was shown on our Face book page and on YouTube. A total of \$3,718.35 was provided to the Youth Fund from this outing. Many thanks to all who supported the event and to our sponsors. Br. Dykas has reserved Dec. 11th for the Deserving Childrens Christmas Party.

Br. Dykasa moved to accept report and pay the reimbursements and bills, seconded by Br. Wasilewski. Motion passed.

<u>Director of Personnel:</u> Br. Kogut – Absent

Social Media Committee: Br. Grzadziel – absent

<u>Custodial Committee:</u> Br. Wasilewski - No report.

<u>Foundation:</u> Br. Ciesla – At the Foundation meeting on 25 July at Colletti's no grant awards were made.

- 7. Old Business: Br. Konopka updated the Board on his conversation regarding a tax-exempt classification from the Illinois IRS. He is providing additional info to the administrative judge and will have another conversation.
- 8. New Business: Br. Konopka received an email asking to have their logos on our website; Porch.com was one of the sites. Anyone could click on the logo and go right to the site. This is being referred to Br. Grzadziel for recommendation.
- 9. Good of the Order: Br. Ciesla reported that Br. Golenia had a debilitating accident at home is recovering after surgery repairing the ligaments in both knees. We hope to see him at the September meeting. Please keep Br. Baczynski in your thoughts as he is having physical problems

10. Adjournment: Motion to adjourn was made by Br Dykas and was seconded by Br. Kurdziel. There being no other business, Br. Konopka adjourned the meeting at 8:07 pm
