

70TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE Polish American Congress

The Polish American Congress (PAC) will celebrate its 70th Anniversary. Commemorative events will take place on May 30 and 31, 2014, in Buffalo, New Yorkthe city where the PAC was founded seven decades earlier.

On Friday, May 30, celebrations will commence with a special Jubilee Conference focused on the issues of unity and cooperation within the Polish American community. A Gala Dinner will follow later that evening. On Saturday, May 31, the PAC will host a trip to the St. Vincent DePaul RC cemetery in Niagara-on-the-Lake, Canada, where we plan to visit our Canadian counterparts, representatives of the Polish Canadian Congress. This unprecedented meeting is going to take place in a historic setting "Haller's Cemetery", a Polish military memorial park in Niagara-on-the-Lake, where we plan to honor the memory of the Polish soldiers from the United States and Canada who volunteered to General Haller's "Blue Army."

Deceased Brother Charles Rozmarek, co founder and first PAC National President from 1944-1968, was Brother Charles Komosa's grandfather. Brother Frank Spula currently serves as national PAC President and will be chairing the conference and coordinating the festivities. Brothers Rom Poplawski, and Charles Komosa, PAC National Directors, and Brother Mark Orwat will be taking a road trip together and motor to Buffalo for the 70th Anniversary. Brother T. Ron Jasinski-Herbert also serves as a National PAC Director.

Honor Flight 54 with Brother Frank Czaja

On April 9, 2014, Brother **Frank Czaja** was fortunate to participate again in The Honor Flight Chicago with his brother bikers. The Honor Flight Chicago's mission is to thank and pay tribute to these heroes—especially our World War II veterans—by bringing them to Washington, D.C., for a day of honor and remembrance at no cost to them. They are also starting to honor our Korean veterans. For more info see their website.

The first thing the returning veterans see is the flag line. This line is composed of bikers from the American Veterans Motorcycle association and a few other groups of bikers. Brother Frank participates in a group organized by the owner, Tina, of the Old Town Pub in Crestwood, Illinois. and her bartender Carla McPhee. Tina has a very strong feeling toward honoring veterans, as do all bikers. So, for each Honor Flight she sponsors a ride from her establishment, at 127th Street and Central. From there the group rides in formation, to Cicero Avenue and then up to Midway Airport. There they meet up with the American Veteran Riders and are issued U.S. flags. They march as a group into the terminal and to the second floor to form the flag line. They cheer the veterans as they pass through and shake each one's hand and thanks him.

This is a heartfelt experience. It is really hard to explain. Perhaps a friend of Czaja's, who is a girl biker, said it the best. She told another girl biker, who was doing this for the first time, to "make sure you have on your waterproof mascara."

There is one Honor Flight a month through October. Brother Frank Czaja will be attending as many as possible. – Great job Brother Frank!
