Dear Brother Members,



Labor of Love Donation Adam Konopka

The Board was recently made aware of two Polish sisters, Olivia and Sara who have been forced to live on their own following the sudden and tragic death of their single, immigrant mother following a two month battle with Their absent father, while alive, has been and remains cancer. permanently out of their lives out of concerns for their own safety. Since the mother's passing, the girls have endeavored to take care of themselves with contributions from their community aka "Fairy Godparents." However, it is clear that the needs of the sisters exceed what the community is able to provide and the Park Ridge Newcomer Club has made them the focus of their annual philanthropic event called the Labor of Love, which will be held on Saturday May 9, 2020. (https:// www.parkridgenewcomersclub.org/Labor-of-Love) The event proceeds will be distributed to a trust created for their benefit and administered by a corporate trustee to be used to address expenses for housing, education and the girls' basic needs.



Moved by the tragedy they faced, the strength they have shown, and the acts of kindness shown by the community via "Fairy Godparents," I am proud to announce the Chicago Society Board voted unanimously at the February meeting to donate \$1,000 from the Youth Fund in order to help fund the trust to support these girls. Somewhere in all of our stories there was a mom, dad or both who took the leap of faith to travel to a new country in order to provide a better life for their families. We are proud and thankful to be able to support this cause, which will help keep that same dream alive for these girls as they look to establish themselves with the help of Polonia.

Let's make the Sledz a big success along with the May 2nd Polish Constitution Day Pre Parade Brunch, **Chairman Zenon Kurdziel**, by attending. We have had really good numbers from outside groups and individuals to attend, why not join them and rub elbows with some dignitaries, or just grab a picture with someone.

This month, we will able to support 2 organizations from our Youth Fund. We will be donating to the Polish Cub Scouts, boys division, where we will be sponsoring their dodgeball tournament, and an organization called the Park Ridge Newcomer Club (PRNC) that will be holding an event called a Labor of Love on Saturday, May 9, 2020 to benefit 2 young ladies. The funds raised will help 2 young Polish girls who lost their mom to cancer and don't have a father. This event is called the Labor of Love.
